Promoting Success Program

The Promoting Success Program is a comprehensive mental health program providing in home or in community counseling as well as psychiatric evaluation and medication management for children and young adults ages 5 -21 and their families. The program will provide an array of services for a minimum of six months to achieve successful outcomes.

This Service is Open to:

- Youth and their families that currently reside in Sussex County
- Youth between the ages of 5 -21 and their families
- Youth and their families in need of in home/in community counseling who have been impacted by mental illness and/or substance abuse
- Youth in need of a psychiatric evaluation and medication monitoring
- Youth not involved with CP&P or CMO unless they are in the termination phase of their case.

This Service Provides:

- Assessment & Evaluation
- Individual and Family Therapy
- Psycho Education Services
- Psychiatric Services via APN for Evaluations and Medication Monitoring
- Linkage and follow-up
